#### TREES, SHRUBS, PLANTS AND FLOWERS

---

##### Entry Fee \$1.00

In Section A as many entries as desired may be made in each class providing each is a different variety and is so labeled. **Labeling varieties of a class increases their value in the judging process**. Please use work tables for set-up. All exhibits must be in place by **8:15 A.M. SHARP Saturday** morning. Plants may be removed Sun. night between 9-10 pm. These classes will be judged by Horticulturists. Containers supplied by the Fair. The exhibitor will provide container for classes 164, 171, 172, 174, 225 and 176.

Best of Class numbers: 146-147, 148a,b, 149a,b, 150a-150c, 154a-154b, 156-157a,b, 158, 159, 160-161, 162-163, 167-168, 171, 172, 173, 175, 176, 177-183, 184-189b, 190-196b, 201-207, 208-212, 213-224.

Best of Show numbers: 146-175 except for classes 171, 172, 174, 175, 176, 177-183a,b, 225.

Best of Show for floral display and/or arrangements. Classes 171, 172, 174 & 176, 225.

Plants removed: **Saturday exhibits Sunday night between 9-10 P.M.**

##### Class No.

145. First time exhibitor
146. Any evergreen tree or shrub **bearing fruit or cone**, cutting not to exceed 30" main branch length. **Only One (1) branch**
147. Any deciduous tree or shrub **bearing flower or fruit**, cutting not to exceed 30" main branch length. **Only One (1) branch**
- 148a. Coleus 8 to 10" pot - single plant **in terracotta looking pot**. No more than 3 entries per entrant. Plants must be growing in a pot minimum 6-8 weeks.
- 148b. Coleus 10 to 14" pot - **in terracotta looking pot**. Three or more (mixed or same variety). No more than 3 entries per entrant. Plants must be growing in a pot minimum 6-8 weeks.
- 149a. "Garden in a Mailbox"- Plant a garden in a mailbox container of your choice. Please use appropriate liner to avoid leaks. Plants must be growing in container for a minimum of six weeks. Please use standard size mailbox not over sized. ONE entry per exhibitor.
- 149b. "Arrangement in Mailbox" - Your choice of cut flowers in a mailbox container of your choice. Please use appropriate liner to avoid leaks. Please use standard size mailbox not over sized. ONE entry per exhibitor
- 149c. "Fairy Tail Garden" with succulent plants 9 x 12 round containers.

## HYDRANGEAS

---

### MACROPHYLLA TYPE (BLUE OR PINK WITH WAXY LEAVES)

- 150a. Hydrangeas single bloom, under 8"
- 150c. Hydrangeas single bloom, 8" and over
- 150d. Hydrangeas 3 stem (uniform in size), under 8"
- 150f. Hydrangeas 3 stem (uniform in size), 8" and over.

**Stem length in proportion to bloom size. Measurement taken at its highest/widest point.**

### PANICULATA TYPE (USUALLY WHITE WITH ROUGH/HAIRY LEAVES)

- 151a. Hydrangeas single bloom, under 8"
- 151c. Hydrangeas single bloom, 8" and over
- 151d. Hydrangeas 3 stem (uniform in size), under 8"
- 151f. Hydrangeas 3 stem (uniform in size), 8" and over.

**Stem length in proportion to bloom size. Measurement taken at its highest/widest point.**

- 152. Snapdragons - 3 stems, any size, any color
- 153. Salvia - 3 blooms or sprays of same variety
- 154a. Sunflower - 3 blooms, same variety, with head 2" to 8" in diameter
- 154b. Sunflower - 3 blooms, same variety, with head over 8" in diameter
- 155a. Kitchen Item with 3 different named plants planted in it (i.e. - Measuring cups, blender, coffee pot, food processor, large cooking pot, etc.) (additional plant materials may be added).  
**Must be planted at least four weeks in container, subject to disqualification if just planted. Limit 2 entries per exhibitor.**

- 155b. Arrangement of cut flowers in kitchen item of exhibitor's choice (i.e. - Measuring cups, blender, coffee pot, food processor, large cooking pot, etc.) Use your imagination! **Must be planted at least four weeks in container, subject to disqualification if just planted. Limit 2 entries per exhibitor.**

- 156a. Zinnias, Giant over 3", 3 blooms any color
- 156b. Zinnias, 2" and over, 3 blooms any color
- 157a. Zinnias, Baby or Pompon under 2" - 3 blooms any color
- 157b. Collection of Zinnias - 5 different varieties, 1 of each variety. Foliage attached May increase judges value
- 158. Any **unscheduled** annual, 3 sprays, spikes or blooms, stem length not to exceed 8" (including bloom) in height. The flower must be in proportion to stem length. i.e. Do not cut large blooms to a 8" stem, same variety. Must name annual on entry form, do NOT need to name variety. **No marigolds NO DATURA** Unscheduled - Does not have a class of it's own. Subject to disqualification.
- 159. Any unscheduled annual, 3 sprays, spikes and blooms, same variety. stem length must be more than 8" but not exceed 30" in height (including bloom). Must name annual on entry form, do NOT need to name variety. No marigolds.
- 160. Any herbaceous perennial, 3 sprays, spikes or blooms of the same variety, stem length not to exceed 8" (including bloom) in height. The flower must be in proportion to stem length. i.e. do not cut large blooms to a 8" stem. **MUST BE ABLE TO WINTER OVER IN OUR GROWING AREA.** Must name perennial on entry form, do NOT need to name variety.
- 161. Any herbaceous perennial, 3 sprays, spikes or blooms, same variety, stem length must be more than 8" but not exceed 30" in height (including bloom) **MUST BE ABLE TO WINTER OVER IN OUR GROWING AREA.** Must name perennial on entry form, do NOT need to name variety.
- 162. Foliage, annual, 3 stems of same variety
- 163. Foliage, perennial, 3 stems of same variety. **MUST BE ABLE TO WINTER OVER IN OUR GROWING AREA.**

- 164a. Any potted pepper, one (1) single pepper plant grown in a terracotta colored pot for at least 6 weeks (if not grown in pot, will be subject to disqualification)
- 164b. Three or four (3 or 4) pepper plants grown in a single terracotta colored pot for at least 6 weeks (if not grown in pot, will be subject to disqualification)
165. Chrysanthemums - 3 sprays, spikes or blooms, same variety
166. Celosia - 3 stems, any color, stem length in proportion to bloom
167. Asters (3 stems, any color)
- 168a. Cleome (3 stems, same color)
- 168b. Cleome - 3 stems, 3 different colors, stems must be in proportion to the flower
169. Field flowers Bouquet - a collection of 7 named varieties of **field** flowers in bloom, which will fit into a litre bottle. Not on a protected list or a hybridized variety. **Invasive plants may not be used. Refer to [www.dec.state.ny.us/index.html](http://www.dec.state.ny.us/index.html)**
170. Collection of 5 different annuals, named. No varieties within same annual
- \*171. Display of cut flowers arranged in a 1 lb. coffee can provided by exhibitor. Judged for horticultural perfection and attractiveness of display. Covers for the can will be supplied by the committee.
172. Container arrangement of Dahlia blooms - 5 different varieties or more blooms named arranged in a container. Foliage other than dahlias may be used. Container to be provided by exhibitor.
- \*173. Collection of white flowers, any number that will fit in a litre bottle, judged for horticultural perfection.
174. Named Holiday Arrangement. Holiday of your choice. Container supplied by exhibitor. Limit 3 arrangements per exhibitor.
175. Collection of Foliage, any number which will fit into a litre bottle. Judged for horticultural perfection.
- \*176. **2018 Feature - "Dutchess County Landmarks"** - A special bouquet or arrangement of exhibitor's choice. Container to be provided by the exhibitor. Foliage or other filler may be used.

## DAHLIAS

**EXHIBITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MEASURING SIZE OF BLOOM AND ENTERING IN THE PROPER CLASS. ENTRY INTO WRONG CLASS IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION. LIMIT OF 3 ENTRIES PER VARIETY PER CLASS. MINIMUM STEM LENGTH 4-6" ATTACHED FOLIAGE MAY ADD VALUE IN THE JUDGES EVALUATION**

*Shown with one flower on a stem with foliage optional.*

*They must be disbudded.*

177. Dahlia - Head over 10" - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, any color
178. Dahlia - Head 8" to 10" - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, lacinated, any color
179. Dahlia - Head 6" to 8" - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, lacinated, any color
180. Dahlia - Head 4" to 6" solid or multicolor - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, lacinated, any color
181. Dahlia - Miniature, up to 4" - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, any color. No pompons or balls
- 182a. Dahlia - Pompons, any color
- 182b. Dahlia - Ball, any color
- 183a. Dahlia - Any other (Waterlily, peony, anemone, single, collarette, orchid, novelty)
- 183b. Dahlia - 3 of same variety

## GLADIOLUS

---

*Stem length not to exceed 20".*

*Stems less than 20" below first floret will be penalized if out of balance.*

*Two florets may be removed.*

*Medium – 2 1/2"    Large – 4"*

- 184. Medium - white or cream
- 185. Medium - yellow
- 186. Medium - orange or salmon
- 187. Medium - pink or rose
- 188. Medium - red
- 189a. Medium - any other color
- 189b. Medium - multi-color
- 190. Large - white or cream
- 191. Large - yellow
- 192. Large - orange or salmon
- 193. Large - pink
- 194. Large - rose
- 195. Large - red
- 196a. Large - lavender, purple or any other color
- 196b. Large - multi-color
- 197. Giant - white, cream, yellow or orange
- 198a. Giant - any other color

- 199. 3 spikes of same variety
- 200a. 5 spikes - all different varieties in a container
- 200b. Arrangement of Glads ( must have at least five Glads) Foliage or filler other than Glads may be used, Container must be provided by the exhibitor.

ALL ROSES MUST BE PROPERLY NAMED

Hybrid teas - Specimen blooms must be shown disbudded. Stem length should be in proportion to size of bloom.
