In Section A as many entries as desired may be made in each class providing each is a different variety and is so labeled except classes 70, 71. **Labeling varieties of a class increases their value in the judging process.** Please use work tables for set-up. All exhibits must be in place by **8:15 A.M. SHARP** Thursday morning. Plants may be removed Fri. night between 9-10 pm. These classes will be judged by Horticulturists. Containers supplied by the Fair except class 90. Any class is subject to subdivision within that class prior to judging. Class numbers 70-71, 72, 73-75, 78, 79, 80, 81, 85a-85b, 87a,b, 88, 90, 91, 93-99, 100-104, 105a-110b, 118-120, 128-133a,b, 134-142 are eligible for Best of Class ribbon. Class numbers 70-91, 93-110b, 111-117a,b, 118-120, 128-144 are eligible for Best of Show ribbon (except for class 90).

FLOWERS AND PLANTS

Class No. ALL MARIGOLDS MUST BE DISBUDDED

70. Marigold - Large Flowered, 3 blooms, over 2"
71. Marigold - Collection of marigolds - 5 different varieties, named. No more than one of each.
- 72a. Cleome - 3 stems, same color, stem must be in proportion to the flower.
- 72b. Cleome - 3 stems, 3 different colors, stem must be in proportion to the flower.
73. Zinnia - Giant over 3", 3 blooms, same color, same variety
74. Zinnia - Baby or pompon 2" and under, 3 blooms, same color.
75. Zinnia - Any other type, 3 blooms, any color, over 2", same variety, same color.
76. Cosmos - 3 blooms same color
77. Aster - Annual, 3 blooms, same color
78. Any **unscheduled** annual, 3 sprays, spikes or blooms, same variety, stem length not to exceed 8" (including bloom) in height. The flower must be in proportion to stem length. i.e. Do not cut large blooms to a 8" stem, same variety. Must name annual on entry form, do NOT need to name variety. **No marigolds NO DATURA** Unscheduled - Does not have a class of it's own. Subject to disqualification.
79. Any unscheduled annual, 3 sprays, spikes or blooms, same variety, stem length must be more than 8" but not to exceed 30" (including bloom). Must name annual on entry form, do NOT need to name variety. **No marigolds NO DATURA** Unscheduled - Does not have a class of it's own. Subject to disqualification.
80. Any herbaceous perennial, 3 sprays, spikes or blooms, same variety, not to exceed 8" in height (including bloom). The flower must be in proportion to stem length. i.e. Do not cut large blooms to a 8" stem. Must name perennial on entry form, do NOT need to name variety. **MUST BE ABLE TO WINTER OVER IN OUR GROWING AREA. NO HYDRANGEAS**
81. Any herbaceous perennial, 3 sprays, spikes or blooms, same variety, not to exceed 30" in height (including bloom). Must name perennial on entry form, do NOT need to name variety. **MUST BE ABLE TO WINTER OVER IN OUR GROWING AREA. NO HYDRANGEAS**

- 82a. "Garden in a Hat." Plant a garden in a hat of your choice (use appropriate liner to avoid leaks). Plants must have been growing in container for a minimum of 6 weeks.
- 82b. "Arrangement in a Hat" of your choice cut flowers (use appropriate liner to avoid leaks).
83. Field Flower Bouquet - A collection of 7 named varieties of field flowers in bloom which will fit in a litre bottle and not on protected list or a hybridized variety. Invasive plant material may NOT be used.
84. Collection of 5 different annuals, named. No varieties within same annual.
- 85a. Sunflower - 3 stems same variety, with head 2" to 8" in diameter
- 85b. Sunflower - 3 stems same variety, with head over 8" in diameter
86. Mums - Any color, 3 sprays (with foliage & 2 or more flowers in bloom)
- 87a. Any annual herb - 3 sprays, spikes or blooms.
- 87b. Any perennial herb - 3 sprays, spikes or blooms (Must be able to winter over in this area)
88. 3 different herbs - potted in a terracotta colored container, no larger than 8"-10". Potted herbs will not be judged against cut herbs.
89. Cut collection of coleus in 1 liter bottle.
- *90. Display of cut flowers, arranged in one pound coffee can provided by exhibitor. Judged for horticultural perfection and attractiveness of display. Covers for cans will be supplied by the committee.
- *91. Collection of yellow and blue/purple, any number which will fit in litre bottle. Judged for horticulture perfection.
92. First time exhibitor's class. May consist of any exhibit listed in Section A or B. Class may be subdivided by committee on day of show if numbers of exhibits warrant it. One Novice Rosette will be placed. One entry only per exhibitor.

Hybrid Teas - Specimen blooms must be shown disbudded.

Stem length should be in proportion to size of bloom.

EXHIBITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MEASURING SIZE OF BLOOM AND ENTERING IN THE PROPER CLASS. ENTRY INTO WRONG CLASS IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION. LIMIT OF 3 ENTRIES PER VARIETY PER CLASS. MINIMUM STEM LENGTH 4-6" ATTACHED FOLIAGE MAY ADD VALUE IN THE JUDGES EVALUATION

- 111. Dahlia - head over 10" - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, any color
- 112. Dahlia - head 8" to 10" - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, laciniated, any color
- 113. Dahlia - head 6" to 8" - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, laciniated, any color
- 114. Dahlia - head 4" to 6" solid color or multi color - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, laciniated, any color. No pompons or balls.
- 115. Dahlia - miniature - up to 4" multi color - formal, informal, semi-cactus, cactus, any color. No pompons or balls.
- 116a. Dahlia - pompons, any color
- 116b. Dahlia - ball, any color
- 117a. Dahlia - any other (waterlily, peony, anemone, single, collarette, orchid, novelty)
- 117b. Dahlia - 3 of the same variety

HYDRANGEAS

MACROPHYLLA TYPE (BLUE OR PINK WITH WAXY LEAVES)

- 119a. Hydrangeas - Single Bloom, under 8"
- 119c. Hydrangeas - Single Bloom, 8" and over
- 119d. Hydrangeas - 3 Stems (uniform in size), under 8"
- 119f. Hydrangeas - 3 Stems (uniform in size), 8" and over

Stem length in proportion to bloom size. Measurement taken at its highest/widest point.

PANICULATA TYPE (USUALLY WHITE WITH ROUGH/HAIRY LEAVES)

- 120a. Hydrangeas - Single Bloom, under 8"
- 120c. Hydrangeas - Single Bloom, 8" and over
- 120d. Hydrangeas - 3 Stems (uniform in size), under 8"
- 120f. Hydrangeas - 3 Stems (uniform in size), 8" and over.

Stem length in proportion to bloom size. Measurement taken at its highest/widest point.

GLADIOLUS

**STEMS LESS THAN 20 INCHES BELOW THE FIRST FLORET WILL
BE PENALIZED IF OUT OF BALANCE.**

**Two florets may be removed. LIMIT 3 ENTRIES PER CLASS.

- 310. My Favorite Color – Flower arrangement featuring your favorite color plus greens
- 311. Grow it for the Bees! – Three plants, named, that attract bees, grown in a container
