provide a mentorship between the students and local landscaping businesses throughout the county. The mentors will

also provide not only their experience with in the field, but they will also be donating the material and judging the

competition.

Tony Capalbo, a member of the Horticulture Committee at the fairgrounds and owner of Phantom Gardener

stated, "The idea for the Jr. Landscaping competition started when the Dutchess Garden Study Club donated \$500 to the

Agricultural Society with the stipulation that the money be given to a student who was interested in a career related to

horticulture or landscape. The Horticulture Committee began discussion on ways to get high school or college students

that are pursuing a career in either of those fields, involved and came up with the Jr. Landscape program." The idea was

presented to the Ag Society, who then offered an additional \$2,000 to this scholarship. A total amount of \$2,500 will be

given to the overall winner of the competition to help with college expenses. Tony continued stating, "This new

program, geared towards high school seniors and college students will help bring a new generation into the Horticulture

Building. We are excited to have these young minds join us at this year's fair."
