and watermelons will also be judged for size. The entries close on August 15, and the

vegetables must be brought to the Fair on Sunday, August 17 between 6pm and 9pm Judging

takes place in the beginning of the week.

Roger Hoffman, one of the Chairmen of the Vegetable Competition (along with Michael

Baden) and a long time growing expert, has offered some advice for the home gardener. "The

key to successful gardening is observation and daily diligence", said Hoffman. "Plan your plant

varieties according to light exposure, height and necessary spacing. Weeding, watering and

control of insects, rodents and disease must be tended to YESTERDAY. By the time TODAY

and TOMORROW arrive it is already too late."
