New for 2024

All sale animals must be identified with species specific identification. Beef, hog, lamb, and goats must have (840 & 982) RFID tags and must be weighed at the designated date and time for their species. The Sale committee has 982 tags and can assist placing at the time of weigh in. Poultry must have leg bands placed by Poultry Advisory and rabbits must be tattooed. If an animal loses identification the DCF Entry Office must be notified within 24 hours so that arrangements can be made to replace the tag/ band.

Participants: Active Dutchess County youth ages 8-18 as of January 1st of current year, enrolled in an approved Dutchess County Youth Program. **The last year you can sell is the year you graduate High School.**

NON-4-H JUNIOR YOUTH LIVESTOCK SHOWS No Entry Fee

RULES:

- 1. Open to all youth between the ages of 5-8 years as of show date. Includes all species.
- 2. Each Jr. Youth exhibitors must own all livestock shown or may show a sponsored animal.
- 3. No Jr. exhibitor may show more than 1 animal.
- 4. For all other rules, turn to the general rules section in the fair book for each species.
- 5. All youth showing in 4-H will not be eligible to show in Junior Youth.
- 6. All participants will receive \$5.00.

Rules:

- 1. One entry per class. Open to ages 5 to 21 as of show date.
- 2. Maximum of two members will be allowed per team.
- The contest will be judged on costume (theme) and presentation. (Speed is judged in Hog Costume Class)
- 4. See individual departments for more specific rules.
- 5. Participants may enter more than one costume class as long as the animal is owned or sponsored.
- 6. In order to be entered into the Costume Class a written short story about your costume must be included with the entry, submitted to the livestock office by 12 noon on Tuesday. The short write up should only be four to six sentences long.
- 7. No costume shall be entered if it has been entered by the same exhibitor previously and awarded prize money at the Dutchess County Fair.

GRAND CHAMPION COSTUME CLASS

The Champions(no substitutions) from each age group, from each costume class show is to return to the Livestock Pavilion on Sunday, August 25th at 12:30pm. If there is no writeup, you will not be considered as a contestant in the Championship Costume Class.

A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be chosen with cash prizes of \$25 and\$15 being awarded.
