- 3. Proof of current rabies vaccination and negative Coggins test is required.
- 4. This show endorses "natural state" grooming guidelines. See the comprehensive show information page, referenced above.
- 5. Youths are those who will be enrolled in grade 8 or lower for the upcoming school year.
- 6. All classes are open to both youths and adults unless otherwise specified.
- 7. Management may combine or split classes, depending on the number of competitors.
- 8. All riders and drivers less than 18 years of age must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute certified) Equestrian Standard.
- 9. Inhumane treatment of animals will result in dismissal from the show.
- 10. Management reserves the right to dismiss unruly animals from the grounds.
- 11. No riding or driving outside the show ring.

- Premium Schedule: 1st \$30, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$15, and 4th \$10
