Showmanship: This class tests the handlers' skills on the ground. Horses should be shown in a halter and lead, English exhibitors will be permitted to show in a bridle.

Leadline Walk Only: Open to exhibitors ages 8 & under or those children with special needs. Handler must be 21 years of age or older and properly attired with long pants, boots and appropriate shirt. This Division will be run in English & Western combined.

Assisted Walk-Trot-Jog: Open to riders in their first year of showing that they may need verbal assistance from a handler in the ring. Handlers will only be allowed to approach horse/rider in an emergency. Handlers in the ring must be 21 years of age or older. This Division will be run in English & Western combined.
